Vaccine delivery is free to metropolitan immunisation providers once a week. CSL may charge for additional vaccine deliveries.

To minimise the potential for vaccine wastage from breaches in the cold chain, please do not maintain large amounts of excess stock in your practice. A single month's worth of buffer stock should be adequate for most practices.
